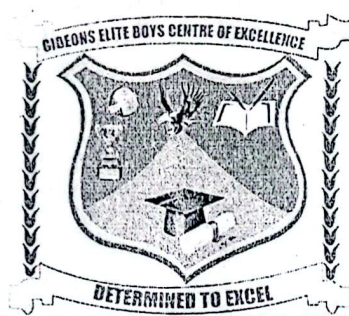

IMPORTANT DATES

ACADEMIC REPORT

Teaching and Learning went on well during the term. We thank our teachers for working hard and completing syllabus early and also to our students for being calm and receptive all through the term. Students have done two exams in this Term, (Cycle 1 and Cycle 2-where cycle two exams comprise of Paper 1, Paper 2 and Paper 3 where applicable for form 3 students). For form 2 students, cycle 2 comprises of Paper 1 and Paper 2, where paper 1 tested form 1 work and paper 2 tested form 2 work. All the marks gained were added and averaged to form his final end of term score/grade. In addition, each individual exam scores are clearly shown in the student report. Kindly note that where a student misses an exam, the score is always computed as 01%. You are reminded to follow up and ensure your son does not miss exams. Students mostly miss cycle 1 exams, because some report late only to find other students through with Cycle 1 exams. Kindly, study it together with your son and guide him academically. They need to remain focused and committed in their studies. All students have been given an assignment, kindly ensure that your son has done the assignment.
